Stop Right Click

Protecting and adding value to your PrestaShop store content —

Keep in mind. Blocking takes place in the visitor's browser: it discourages casual copying of your content but does not constitute absolute protection against a determined or technical user. The module is designed as a deterrence and attribution tool, not as a DRM.

1. Overview

Stop Right Click lets you deter the copying of your images and texts (right-click, selection, drag and drop, keyboard shortcuts) and, above all, turn any unavoidable copy into an SEO advantage thanks to the automatic attribution of a link back to your store. The module also adds a watermark to your images, print protection, email address protection and a statistics dashboard (premium).

2. Installation

1. From the back office, go to *Modules* → *Module Manager* → *Upload a module*, or copy the `stopclick` folder into the `/modules` directory.
2. Install the module. By default, right-click is blocked across the whole store.
3. Click **Configure** and adjust the options in each tab (see below).

3. Configuration

Mouse tab

- **Stop right-click:** disables the context menu across the whole store.
- **On images only:** limits blocking to images.
- **Exceptions:** keep right-click on form fields and links so as not to disrupt navigation.
- **Stop selection** and **Stop drag and drop:** prevent text highlighting and image dragging.

Keyboard tab

Check the Ctrl/Cmd combinations to disable (e.g. Ctrl+S, Ctrl+U, Ctrl+C). Test your store afterwards: some shortcuts are also used by the browser or by other modules.

Alert tab

Choose between a simple browser alert and a SweetAlert window. For the window, customize the theme (Facebook, Google, Twitter), the title, the message (HTML supported), the icon, the animation, the button text and color, automatic closing and closing with the Esc key. Leave both disabled to block silently.

Attribution tab

Enable the addition of a source link to copied content. When a visitor copies your text, a citation and a link to the page are added to what they paste. Set the minimum selection length and, optionally, the credit of the page author (meta author tag). Works even if selection is allowed.

Advanced tab

- **Print protection:** *watermark* mode (adds a copyright notice with the store name and URL) or *blocking* mode (hides the content, prints only the notice).
- **Image watermark:** overlays a text watermark (store name by default) on images above a minimum size.
- **Email protection:** obfuscation of mailto links, rebuilt by the browser on click.

Exclusion tab

- **Allowed IP addresses:** not affected by blocking ("Add my IP" button).
- **Allow employees:** any employee logged into the back office retains full access in the front office (same browser).
- **Page targeting:** apply protection on all pages or only on the selected types (home, product, category, CMS, brand, supplier, search, others).

Statistics tab (premium)

With an active license, enable tracking: a dashboard counts blocked attempts (right-click, copy, drag, keyboard shortcuts) over 30 days and in total. Anonymous data, from the front office, excluding excluded IPs and employees.

4. Theme integration

Two CSS classes let you fine-tune the behavior from your theme or your CMS content:

Class	Effect
<code>lbExclude</code>	The element's content is excluded from copy-paste attribution (no citation added).
<code>stopclick-no-wm</code>	Images contained in the parent element are ignored by the watermark.

5. Privacy

The statistics function only stores aggregated anonymous counters (event type and day) in a dedicated table. No IP address, no personal data, no visitor identifier is recorded. The front-end script does not load any third-party service.

6. FAQ

Does this really protect my content?

No protection running in the browser is absolute: a screenshot or viewing the source code remain possible. The goal is to raise the bar for casual users. For real protection, combine the module with low-resolution images, a visible watermark and your legal notices.

Does this affect my search engine ranking?

No. The script only runs on the front office and never blocks search engine robots, which do not use the context menu. The back office is never affected.

Does attribution work if selection is blocked?

No: if "Stop selection" is enabled, the visitor cannot copy, so no attribution is added. Attribution makes sense when selection remains allowed.
